1345.01 ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES; CONSIDERATIONS.

A certificate of occupancy and/or use shall be issued in accordance with the approved fee schedule to an applicant for any building or structure after such building or structure has been inspected in its complete form if such building or structure is found to have been constructed or altered in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor and to comply with the provisions of the Ohio Basic and City Building Codes, all other applicable City ordinances and the rules and regulations of the Department of Public Service, including but not limited to the sidewalk ordinances of the City, and if sidewalks have been installed on the real estate on which any such building or structure is situated in accordance with the sidewalk ordinances of the City. The inspection required by this section shall also specifically include a review of any driveway and/or driveway addition. (Ord. 41-17. Passed 7-25-17.)
